

Feversham College Year 7 Catch-up Premium

Priorities for the Catch-up Premium

The literacy and numeracy Catch-up Premium provides schools with attritional funding to support Year 7 pupils who did not achieve the national expectation in reading and for mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2.

At Feversham our aim is to enable pupils entering the College who are below national average to catch up by the end of Year 7. The intention is to maximize the percentage of pupils with low prior attainment who achieve a "strong pass" or at least a "standard pass" in English and Maths.

A funding allocation is made to the College for every pupil who has not achieved the desired level in reading and/or writing at Key Stage 2 as per the October school census.

2016-2017 Outcomes and Spend Profile

The College provided:

- Additional teaching assistant support to those pupils eligible in Maths and English lessons
- Additional teaching groups were created to allow small group lessons for catch up in Maths and English
- Additional lessons were timetabled in year 7 for catch-up pupils

The college monitored the catch-up pupils and funding in the following ways:

- Formal assessments for all pupils each half term
- Formative assessments through progress meetings with Heads of Departments
- Tracking and monitoring of class work and in class interventions against summative data points
