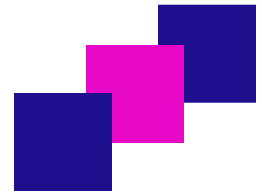


## Anti-Bullying Week



Students raised awareness of bullying whilst also raising money for The Lunchbowl Network in a week of activities.
