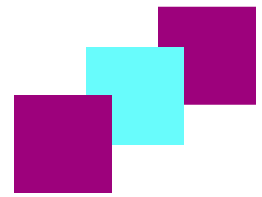


Helping the Homeless



Students help the homeless in school's Winter Drive.

Students at Feversham have been investigating homelessness by looking at the variety of reasons as to why people become homeless. They looked at images of homeless people and discussed how they may be feeling and where they can get help. They also looked at society's attitudes towards homelessness and the stereotypes involved. They were encouraged to perform random acts of kindness by helping a needy person throughout the drive.

Students then donated warm clothing, like gloves and socks, and food like chocolate. Students gathered together their donations into boxes which they then decorated in GST groups.

The boxes were donated to Inn Churches, a local charity helping vulnerable adults who are homeless or at risk of homelessness in Bradford. They offer advice and guidance to those with a housing crisis and in winter offer over-night accommodation in local churches.
