All students will receive **points** as rewards ranging from 1 to 3 points. Points can be gained for **positive behaviour** and lost for **negative behaviour**


Points will be saved in Individual Point Banks

P O I N T S All students are awarded points using the Behaviour Management System

Points are awarded for good behaviour, hardwork, extracurricular and positive contributions.

Points are lost for any negative behaviour logged by staff and subtracted from the overall total.

All points are saved in students individual point accounts which can be accessed using their individual password.

Supporting School Rules

Students and parents are expected to fully support the school rules.

Students should not wear jackets, coats or non-school uniform cardigans in the school building.

Please note the following are also **prohibited** in school:

- Chewing gum
- Mobile phones
- Jewellery (including nose studs)
- Photographs
- MP3 Players
- Cameras
- Make up including Surma

Prohibited items will be removed and may be confiscated by staff. Students may also receive other sanctions. Prohibited items such as mobile phones will only be returned to parents.

Mobile Phones

If for exceptional reasons a student needs to have a mobile phone whilst travelling to and from school parents need to contact House Leaders and arrange for the phone to be handed in at the start of the school day and collected at the end.

Students must NOT keep / carry phones during the school day.

After School Detention

The College will inform parents via a letter, a note in the planner, telephone calls, text messages or other means as appropriate. Where possible we will give 24 hours notice. However, the College reserves the right to issue onthe-day after school detentions.

The time and date of after-school detentions will not be changed unless there are exceptional circumstances. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure appropriate transport arrangements are made for their daughter to attend the detention.

Attendance - Every day counts

Students should attend College every day. This will give them the very best chance of achieving and being successful. Being absent means students miss the notes and work the teachers do and also any discussions, group work and questioning that happens. Students can NEVER copy those up.

If students are very ill and cannot come into College parents must inform College as soon as possible by ringing the school.

Students are rewarded every term for attendance;

100% Attendance Gold certificate, 3 positive points and

postcard sent home.

98% Attendance Silver certificate, 2 positive points and

postcard sent home.

At the end of each term the best attending class in each community is awarded a collective prize.

Every two weeks the best attending class in each house is awarded a certificate and trophy.

Students who achieve 100% attendance for the full academic year will be awarded with a HORSE RIDING REWARD TRIP.
